**Water Meter Readings**

You may have noticed that we have not updated the monthly water usage on our website home page since July. The reason for this is that our meter reading device and the office support software are no longer supported by the manufacturer, Badger Meter out of Sacramento. This is our mea culpa, as we should have known about this forthcoming obsolescence, but it slipped through the cracks. We have placed an order for the necessary updated software and new read device hardware. With the supply chain backorders, and training on the new software, it might be December before we will read the meters again. At that time, they will record all the water usage since the last meter reading, so there will be no data lost. But we have to apologize for your inability to see this data on a monthly basis.

Long term, when funds allow, we would hope to upgrade our meters (just as PSD is planning to do with a grant they got from Placer County) so that you will be able to log onto a website at any time and see your real time water usage and any leak alerts.

**Construction**

With the smoke and rain, Rapid Construction has lost enough work days that we will definitely not finish all the projects we had on schedule for this construction season. Sandy is completely done, and Paiute and Washoe are complete except for slurry sealing. Rapid is now working on West Christy, and plan to complete that work before the cut-off date of Oct 15<sup>th</sup>. Navajo will get moved into next summer along with replacing our main feed pipe through Squaw Summit HOA up to the lower tank.

**Other**

We have had our lower tank inspected and it checked out great. The company was not able to get to the upper tank (due to the road conditions) so we will need to reschedule that.

Next Board Meeting is Nov 4<sup>th</sup>.
